## What is Arts in the Parks?

Arts in the Parks has been a major program of Arts Place since 1977. Hundreds of students participate in classes each year. The program introduces young people to a variety of visual and performing arts activities.

This year workshop sites are being held in Adams, Auglaize, Blackford, Jay and Mercer counties. **Arts Place welcomes New Bremen, Ohio to Arts in the Parks!**

## Who May Attend?

The activities are designed for students who have COMPLETED the first grade and older. Some classes have age requirements. Check the class listings for details. There is a modest cost for students to attend, due to the generosity of numerous donors. Scholarships are available. To apply simply fill out the registration form and return it with your payment. Parents are welcome to attend any activity with their children.

## What Does It Cost?

All regular daytime classes are \$5 each or \$20 for unlimited classes. Additional fees apply for Family Night and Arts in the Parks Goes to Camp.

## How Do I Sign Up?

Complete the registration form and return the original form and payment to Arts Place's Portland Center. Priority will be given to registrations received by May 20th. ## PRICING

- All regular daytime Arts in the Parks classes are \$5 each or \$20 for unlimited classes
- Family Nights are \$5 per family project (up to four family members). Additional projects are \$5 each. Family Nights are not included as part of the \$20 unlimited classes.
- Arts in the Parks Goes to Camp costs \$49 and includes lunch and a snack. Arts in the Parks Theatre Camp costs \$20. Please notify Arts Place if your child has any food allergies.

## About Family Nights

Family Night returns to Arts in the Parks with an array of different classes focusing on a family project that you can work on together.

Make the arts an experience that the whole family can take part in! Enjoy your time together and come away with a project that you've done as a family.

## About Arts in the Parks Goes to Camp

**June 22-26, 9am-3pm \$49**

Back by popular demand, this program is designed to accommodate families with children who wish to participate in Arts in the Parks, but were unable in past years because their parents work and they did not have a way to get to class.

This year we will hold a week-long camp and a two-day theatre camp. See the Class Descriptions for more about Arts in the Parks Theatre Camp.

Camp will take place from 9am-3pm, allowing kids to be dropped off in the morning before parents go to work, and to be picked up in the afternoon around the same time they are released from school during the school year.

There will be morning, mid-day, and afternoon sessions in many different media, punctuated by lunch, snack, and recess breaks. Kids will have enough downtime to be relaxed in this creative environment.

Arts in the Parks Goes to Camp is developed to offer children both a fun experience and an intensive experience in the arts by learning

## Class Descriptions

Here's a list of this year's classes. Check the community listings for classes near you.

### **Potter's Wheel** Ages 9+

Learn to throw clay on the wheel. After glazing the pottery, we will even take part in a Raku firing (see schedule for Raku days). Get ready to get dirty!

### **Arty Pants**

Bring your favorite jeans to class and turn them into a work of art!

### **Raku Firing**

Raku is the ancient Japanese art form of "flash" firing. We pull red hot pots from the kiln and set them ablaze in a barrel of straw. Lots of smoke, fire, and fun! Bring your own pieces made during Art in the Parks, or pick one that has already been made! Glaze it with a combination of different colors and then stand back and watch the magic!

### **Mister Master Music Madness**

Learn to recognize 8 music masters and some of their greatest works in this fun interactive class.

### **Music Alive**

Do you want to learn to read music? This technique is the most fun ever! Learn to read the notes on the staff by becoming the music.

### **Out of Your Gourd** Ages 9+

Gourds are not just birdhouses anymore! We'll scrape, drill, cut, burn and dye the gourds to make beautiful decorative pieces!

### **Paper Stories**

Using the stories of your town, we'll tear, cut and collage to

create an image embedded right into handmade paper.

### **Art Quilt**

Using tales from your town, we'll cut, glue, sew and embellish a story right into the fabric!

### **Look Again!**

Children will explore the photography exhibit in our galleries and go on a scavenger hunt

### **TNBT (The Next Big Thing)**

If you could invent the Next Big Thing, what would it be? Paper maché yourself into this mess!

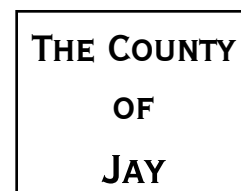
